

**Eralin Kuandyk Yeraluly** Doctor of Pedagogical Sciences, professor, cultural figure of the Republic of Kazakhstan, member of the Union of Artists of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Kuandyk Yeraluly, 04/14/1950. was born. He graduated from Yrgyz secondary school in 1968, Shymkent Pedagogical Institute in 1973, studied at the graduate school of the Moscow Pedagogical Institute (1982-1985), and doctoral studies (1998-1993). Teacher 414 Russian School of Railways in Zhusaly (1973-1975), senior teacher at Shymkent Pedagogical Institute (1975-1996), OKSU named after M. Auezov (1996-2004), State Technical University named after. A. Yasawi (2004-2013), senior lecturer, held the positions of professor, head of department, dean. Currently he is a professor at Moscow State Technical University.

In 1986, he defended his dissertation for the academic degree of Candidate of Pedagogical Sciences at the Moscow State Pedagogical Institute named after V.I. Lenin; in 1993, he defended his dissertation for the academic degree of Doctor of Pedagogical Sciences at Moscow State Pedagogical University. associate professor, in 1993, by decision of the Central Executive Committee of the Russian Federation, he was awarded the academic degree of Doctor of Pedagogical Sciences. In 1997, by the decision of the Central Election Commission of the Republic of Kazakhstan (nostrification), he was awarded the academic degree of Doctor of Pedagogical Sciences. Sciences awarded the title of professor in 1999.

In 1998, he organized a dissertation council for the defense of a candidate's degree in the specialty of teaching fine arts in school, secondary and higher educational institutions at OKSU named after. M. Auezova, 13.00.02-, deputy chairman, member of this council, in 2005-2010 doctoral student at KSU named after. A. Yasawi was a member of the council. From 1998 to 2010, he worked as a scientific supervisor and consultant in the preparation of 17 candidates of science and 4 doctors of pedagogical sciences. He was a member of the educational and methodological council at the USSR Ministry of Education, specializing in fine arts and drawing. 345 scientific and methodological works were published.

In 1988-1992, the publishing house of the Moscow Pedagogical Institute "Prometheus" published 4 monographic works on artistic, artistic-practical, methodological issues in the training of future teachers of fine arts. Articles from scientific journals included in the SCOPUS and The books "The Art of Carpets",

"Visualization of Kazakhstan. Art". Of the trained scientists, 2 work in Uzbekistan, 1 in Karakalpakstan, 1 in Turkey, 1 in Greece, the rest work in Kazakhstan. Member of the expert commission of the Ministry of Science and Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan on assessing the quality of textbooks on fine arts "Design" for teachers and students of fine arts and drawing", The main readings written for students, masters and doctoral students studying "Decorative Arts" are: "Fine Arts of Kazakhstan", "Methodology of teaching fine arts", "Methodology of teaching drawing", "Composition", "Decorative arts", "Methodology of teaching special subjects", "Fundamentals of design", "Introduction to the profession", "History and theory of fine arts", "Artistic training", "Methodological preparation", "Fundamentals of design", "Ethnodesign", "Innovations in teaching fine arts", "Decorative image", "Realistic image", "Evaluation of fine works", "Abstract representation") at present time are used in the educational process of schools and higher educational institutions.

Twice laureate of a grant from the Ministry of Science and Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan for excellence in a higher educational institution of Kazakhstan (2008, 2015), awarded a Certificate of Honor from the Minister of Science and Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan. Kazakhstan (2020), honorary title of Cultural Worker of the Republic of Kazakhstan (2007), accepted as a full member of the Academy of Natural Sciences (1995). Awarded the Y. Altynsarin medal (2010), the badge "For services to the Turkestan region" (2021), and the badge of an eloquent teacher (2020).

Mateev's wife Tengesh Shataykovina graduated from the Shymkent Pedagogical Institute, taught at the school and university named after A. Yasawi at the Faculty of Mathematics and retired. The eldest daughter Aigul is a professor at the Turkestan University of Tourism, Candidate of Sciences, Nazgul works at Atomprom, Gaziz Peoples' Friendship University, Candidate of Sciences, Indira is an economist, Serik is a businessman.
